Ecological Relationship	Organism 1	Organism 2	Who Benefits
Competition Two or more organisms vying for the same food or energy source.			
Predation One organism (predator) kills and consumes another organism (prey).			
Mutualism A relationship in which both organisms benefit.			
Parasitism One organism (parasite) takes food from another organism (host), without actually killing it.			
Commensalism A relationship in which one organism benefits, while the other organism is not affected.
